1. What does peace look like for you?
2. Read Ephesians 2:11-22.
 - a. What were the causes of divisions between Gentiles (the uncircumcised) and the Jews (the circumcision)?
 - b. In what ways did Christ bring peace to those who were once divided?
 - c. What can we learn from this in our modern context, particularly as we think about preaching the gospel in a diverse city?
3. Look at Matthew 11:28-29 where Jesus invites us to come to him for peace. What are some of the ways that you need his peace personally? Take time now to pray for each other's burdens.
4. Ephesians 2:1-3 tells us that those who are 'dead in transgressions' are 'objects of [God's] wrath. Pray for those you know who need to have peace with God through faith in Christ.
