3. What could we learn from how Daniel conducted himself in vv10-11? How are we to go about living out our faith in a hostile world?
4. How does this chapter challenge our understanding of passages like 1 Peter 2:13-14, which say we should obey the law of the land? What other passages could we look to?
5. How could you use Daniel 6 to explain *grace* to an unbelieving friend?
